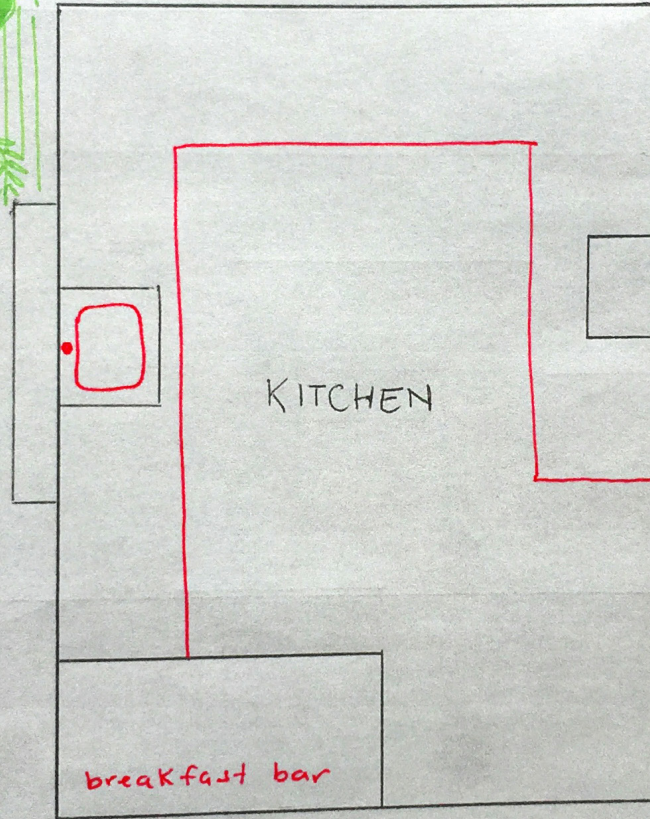


I don't remember much about the kitchen at all - the outdoor shower could be seen from the window - I liked all the plants that grew by the shower
